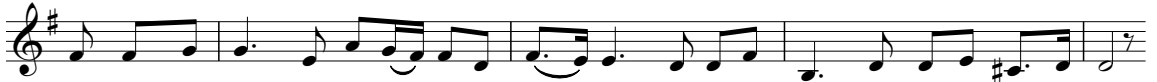


MY GREAT SALVATION (THE SIGN OF JONAH)
